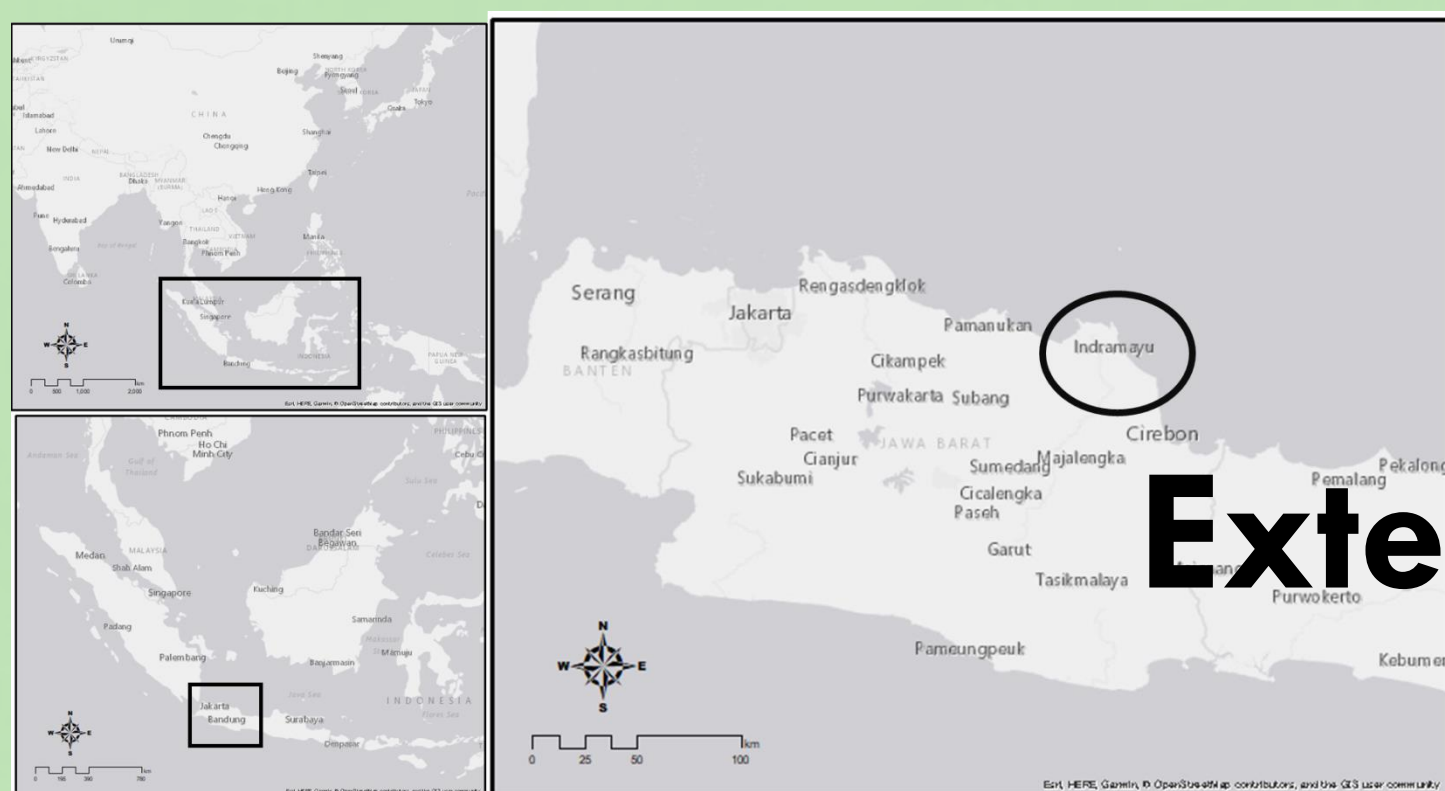

## For sustainable community development...

We examine fishers' satisfaction and potential factors for affecting their satisfaction by using regression analysis. Economic value of ecosystem services for fishers is examined through socio-economic survey.

## Research Purpose

## Fishers' satisfaction

Individual satisfaction affects both individual and group behavior. Understanding fishers' current satisfaction is important and necessary for sustainable community development.



## Potential factors

The factors depend on their life and work environment. At the same time when surveying fishers' satisfaction, the potential factors are examined.

## Explanatory variables

### Individual characteristics

(e.g., age, religion, ethnicity, academic career, number of offsprings etc.)

### Occupational characteristics

(e.g., fishing type, fishing gear, vessel size, etc.)

### Community characteristics

(e.g., operational roles of fishing, etc.)

## Dissatisfaction level and Concern for the future

We examine dissatisfaction level of fishers and concern for the future. The reason of the answer is collected. In the questionnaire, dissatisfaction level is quantified by using 5 level scales from 1 (Not dissatisfied) to 5 (Very dissatisfied).

## Utility

of natural resources for fishers

Whether fisherman has a perspectives about natural resources is examined. By doing that, we can see if fisherman actually get benefit from ecosystem services and improve their own life.

Potential factors are determined based on Ostrom's framework (Ostrom, 2007)

- 2) Resource unit
- 3) Governance system
- 4) Users
